

Doctors, or Apothecaries marked as containing Glass, Cases of Stuffed Birds, Whips, Parcels of Mouldings, Bakers' Peels, Oars, Gas Pipes, etc.; also Uninsured Parcels, containing brittle articles, such as Glass or China, are charged 50 per cent. increase upon the ordinary Parcel Rates.

Parcels of an objectionable nature, or containing explosives, or likely to damage others, will not be received.

Parcels containing Live Stock, Fowl, Dogs, etc., are carried solely at Owner's risk, and will not be received on any other condition.

In no case will the Company be responsible for any parcel valued over £5, unless the value is declared when booking, and insurance thereon paid in accordance with notices exhibited in the Company's Offices.

No claim for loss or damage to parcels handed to a passing tram-car will be recognised unless the number of the car is taken at the time, and sent in with the written Statement of Claim.

In all cases of through booked parcels passing through the hands of more than one Company, the several Companies are liable only so far as their own lines are concerned.

Parcels "to be kept till called for" if remaining on hands over 24 hours will be liable to storage charges.

The Consignee is required, at the time of delivery, to make any complaint as to breakage, etc., by marking same on Receipt Docket before signing, as otherwise the Company will not be responsible, nor will any claim unless so made be recognised.

Consignees are particularly requested not to pay money to Messengers unless in exchange for an official receipt.

If advice notes have to be sent, postage on same will be collected along with usual charges.
