## NOTICE TO PASSENGERS.

1. Cars will stop to allow passengers to enter or alight only at fixed points. These points are indicated on the street poles.
  2. Any person getting on or off the Cars between these points will do so at their own Risk. Passengers are requested when alighting to face the direction in which the car is proceeding.
  3. The Fares will be collected shortly after passengers enter the car.
  4. Passengers are cautioned against pulling the Conductor's bell or interfering with the trolley rope.
  5. The attention of passengers is called to Bye-laws Nos. 10 and 11 respectively:—
  10. Every passenger shall, upon demand, pay to the conductor, or other duly authorised officer of the Company, the fare legally demandable for the journey, and a ticket corresponding thereto shall be delivered to such passenger by the conductor, and such passenger shall accept and retain such ticket until demanded previous or at the end of the journey.
  11. Every passenger shall show his ticket to any duly authorised officer of the Company when required by him so to do.
- Any person offending against or committing a breach of same, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty shillings.
